1998-2003 Fellowship Chair Roy Troutt and newsletter editor Jack Mayo served the history fellowship together these past five years with Roy recognizing Jack's contributions by asking him to serve as Assistant Fellowship Chair 2000-2003, so it came as no surprise that our Nominating Committee tapped Jack to follow Roy as Fellowship Chair.

Rotary/One = the original

The Rotary Club of Chicago, known as Rotary/One, was the original club upon which 31,500 additional clubs have been patterned. The 100th anniversary of Rotary / One's first meeting is February 23, 2005.

Jack Selway, founder and chairman of The History of Rotary (THOR) Project, (an affiliate of RHHIF) spoke to the club last May. In addition to R. I. President-Elect Glenn Estess and District Governor James P. Ahstrom Jr., other visiting Rotarians included: Past R. I. Director

RI's Constitution and Bylaws Committee provides each district's delegate to the June 2004 event with a compilation of resolutions and enactments that were submitted by clubs and districts in a timely fashion.

Adopted by the Rotary Club of Austin, Texas, and endorsed by 5780's District Conference, it encourages clubs to consider having a Club Archivist to oversee collection and storage of historical material and a Club Historian to annually update the club's history of community, vocational and international service projects undertaken.

Your club history informs guest speakers and prospective members and is useful when RI and club anniversaries provide occasions to talk about contributions to your community.
