Heritage Trail leads to *Comely Bank*

The history fellowship intends to add the Founder's home, known as *Comely Bank*, to the Rotary Heritage Trail by June 19, 2005 when the Rotary Centennial Convention brings tens of thousands of Rotarians to the Chicago area.

Heritage Trail begins at the Racine Wisconsin birthplace of Paul Harris, then gives you a 90 minute drive south to the Rotary International Headquarters building to see Room 711 and Paul's law office (inside RI Headquarters), then you drive past — and perhaps someday go into — *Comely Bank*, and finally down to Mount Hope Cemetery. The trip can be done in half a day.

More than a million dollars might be required to buy the house, restore it to the way it looked during Paul's lifetime, and add conveniences required to convert the building from a single family residence into a public gathering place (museum) including compliance with ADA code.

We gratefully acknowledge those Rotarians who have donated their professional services — architects, structural engineers, and historic preservation experts who have also had experience with the public exhibition and utilization of an historic residence. Our fellowship Board appreciates the advice and encouragement provided by these Rotarians.
